NCGIA is pleased to announce we are offering attendee scholarships for the 2024 Annual Gangs Across the Carolinas Conference in Winston Salem, NC. The scholarship will provide free tuition to awarded attendees to the 2024 annual NCGIA Conference to further their knowledge, training and experience for Gang investigations.

This scholarship will be announced to NCGIA members from their Regional Coordinators during their meetings so members can apply for the scholarship and forward the scholarship application to other potential attendees that may benefit from the scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded to applicants who are members in good standing or new members who meet NCGIA membership criteria.
